During his 7 years at Chetham's school of music, Adam Riding performed in a number of successful chamber ensembles, one of these giving concerts in Lithuania, Norway, Jersey, and Italy. He was a member of the Cheetham's symphony orchestra, giving concerts regularly at the Bridgewater hall, Cadogan Hall, and the Royal festival Hall - on one occasion, for Prince Edward himself.

Since then Adam continued his studies at the RNCM, under the tuition of Ben Holland, regularly partaking in numerous masterclasses with visiting professionals there: Sofia Jaffa, Paul Barret. In his third year, Adam completed an Erasmus year in Essen at the "Folkwang Universität der Künste" under the tuition of Pieter Daniel where he partook in numerous solo, chamber and orchestral opportunities; his piano quartet finding success that year, giving concerts in The Hague, and within Amsterdam

Since having graduated from the RNCM, Adam has taken part in numerous concerts with the BBC Philharmonic, giving concerts in both the Media City studio and the Bridgewater Hall and is currently auditioning for an official 'extra' position with the BBC.
